

Program Description

This advanced 3-day program has been expertly designed for experienced team coaches and coach supervisors aiming to enhance their supervisory skills in response to the worldwide shortage of trained team coach supervisors. The program is derived from an EMCC-accredited Coaching Supervision Diploma 3-day module (CSTD).

Individuals eager for ongoing supervision and mentoring can choose to enrol in an additional action learning and supervision group, which meets monthly for a duration of six months.

This virtual program accommodates international participation and is facilitated by the global leaders in the Systemic Team Coaching field, Professor Peter Hawkins, who has been training coaches and coach supervisors for over 20 years, and Dr Catherine Carr, who is an EMCC accredited master team and individual/mentor coach and individual coach supervisor. This training program is essential for the professional development of both aspiring and seasoned team coach supervisors alike.

Entry Eligibility

This program is suitable for individuals who have experience with team coaching (preferably graduates or current students of the AoEC / Renewal Associates one-year Systemic Team Coaching® Practitioner Diploma or a similar program) and have either practical experience or hold a qualification in coach supervision.

For individuals with team coaching experience who require a foundational training in supervision, we are offering a full supervision training later in 2025.
